(U) Hampton University Visit and Meeting at USAMRMC (U) (MCMR-SD).

Four key representatives from Hampton University traveled to Fort Detrick and provided USAMRMC's Principal Assistant for Research and Technology and others an overview of their medical research and allied health capabilities. As one of the nation's premier Historically Black Colleges and Universities and Minority Institutions (HBCU/MI), Hampton University is seeking to forge strategic business relationships within USAMRMC and other mission partners located on the Fort Detrick Installation.

This particular visit and meeting is a follow-up from a previous meeting in which the USAMRMC Associate Director, OSBP traveled to Hampton University in January 2008 and provided information about the command's vision, missions and our proactive stance in establishing and retaining collaborations with academia.
